





WINTER WRUP-CYCLING

Winter Wrup-Cycling revives recycled materials into high-quality coverings. This upcycling process has been developed by Winter & Company. It allows to recycle valuable raw materials, ensures that they are used for high-quality products and do not end up as waste. Winter Wrup-Cycling was applied to the development of Satin Ocean, a qualitative textile, cover material.

Satin Ocean consists of more than 50% recycled yarns. It is very durable and easy to process. Due to the high percentage of recycled fibres it contributes to a sustainable economy.



WASTE EQUIVALENT

The use of PET plastic bottles waste is an effective way to reduce the environmental impact.

The recycling process produces a new product, Satin Ocean, an elegant quality of recycled plastics. At the same time saving a significant amount of waste that would otherwise have gone to landfill and sea.

OCEAN PLASTIC

Measure against a 0.5 litre bottle of 14 grams, 1 square metre of Satin Ocean contains approximately 7.3 PET bottles from the ocean. Satin Ocean strongly and directly supports jobs in rural areas and fair wages. Local fishermen are trained and paid for collecting, sorting, washing and shredding of plastic waste. The yarn used in Satin Ocean originates from the Andaman Sea in Southeast Asia where the cleanup effort is centred on and around five islands. The recycled ocean plastics are collected and upcycled by our partner organisation tide ocean SA (#tide).
